Applications must be accompanied by all requested letters and documentation.

- Copy of both sides of your final information acknowledgment letter for 2020-2021 Student Aid report (SAR) (Form OMB No.1845-0008) as a result of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which indicates the estimated family contribution (EFC).
- College Entrance Examination Board and/or Graduate Record Examination Scores
- Letter of academic record.
- Letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or De Molay Chapter.
- Copy of the first two pages of Federal Tax Return (Form 1040) for 2021 for you and your parents (unless you are self supporting).
