Dear Applicant: This application and all required information are to be personally completed/procured by you. All materials must be submitted to the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Massachusetts, Attn: Educational Grant Committee, 186 Tremont Street, Suite 405, Boston, MA **02111-1096** and postmarked no later than May 1, 2024. Applications must be accompanied by all requested letters and documentation.

ALL of the following items MUST accompany the completed application:

- Copy of both sides of your 2023-2024 Student Aid Report as a result of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which indicates the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
- Copy of most recent academic transcript.
- Letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or DeMolay Chapter.
- Copy of the first two pages of your Federal Tax Return for 2023 and of the first two pages of your parents' Federal Tax Return for 2023.
- Personal statement of up to 250 words (equivalent of one typed page) of your academic goals and how the Grant will help you accomplish them.
