Applications must be accompanied by all requested letters and documentation.

- Copy of both sides of your 2022-2023 Student Aid Report as a result of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which indicates the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
- Copy of most recent academic transcript.
- Letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or DeMolay Chapter.
- Copy of the first two pages of your Federal Tax Return for 2021 and of the first two pages of your parents' Federal Tax Return for 2021.
- **Personal statement** of up to 250 words (equivalent of one typed page) of your academic goals and how the Grant will help you accomplish them.
